Testimony Guidelines and Instructions:

Submit the testimony as a Word file attachment to comments@imls.gov. **Please conform to the following guidelines in your statement:**

- Do not exceed five pages for testimony;
- Your testimony must be single-spaced on 8.5 by 11 inch (letter size) paper, with one-inch margins and at least 12 point font; however, addendum in appropriate bold type and bullets are acceptable, as long as they are within the five page maximum length;
- Clearly indicate your name, title, institutional affiliation and hearing name center-spaced at the top of the first page; and
- Clearly state in the first paragraph that you are addressing, IMLS Director Susan H. Hildreth, and The National Museum and Library Services Board (NMLSB).
- Links to additional comments are permitted.
- Statements must be received no later than April 24, 2014, for it to be included in the printed hearing volume. comments@imls.gov
- Comments will be posted on the IMLS web site and provided to relevant congressional committees and made available in a letter from the IMLS director the chairman of the FCC.
