<b>STATEMENT OF NEED</b>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Is the project clearly explained?</li> <li>• How well does the project address the challenge identified in this funding initiative?</li> <li>• Is the research well-grounded in current literature and practice?</li> </ul>
<b>IMPACT</b>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Are the project’s performance goals and intended results clearly articulated, appropriate, and realistic?</li> <li>• Does the project demonstrate the potential for significant benefit to and applicability across the museum and library fields?</li> </ul>
<b>PROJECT DESIGN</b>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Do the identified staff, partners, consultants, and service providers possess the expertise and skills necessary to complete the work successfully?</li> <li>• Are the theoretical approach, research questions, methods, and design likely to be efficient, and effective in and appropriate to accomplishing the goals of this initiative?</li> <li>• Is the schedule of work realistic and achievable?</li> <li>• Are the financial, personnel, partnering, and other resources identified appropriate for the scope and scale of the project?</li> <li>• Is a clear methodology described for tracking the project’s progress and adjusting course when necessary?</li> <li>• Is there an effective plan for communicating the work and/or sharing discoveries?</li> </ul>
